Notice of Public Hearing Adoption of the Town of Kill Devil Hills CAMA Land Use Plan Update

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina will conduct a public hearing on September 14, 2020, at 6:00 p.m. to receive public comment, both written and oral, on the Town of Kill Devil Hills Coastal Area Management Act (CAMA) Land Use Plan Update. The public hearing will be held in the Meeting Room at the Administration Building, 102 Town Hall Drive (off Colington Road), Kill Devil Hills, NC.

Written comments, which will be included with the record of the public hearing, may be submitted to the Town Clerk, P.O. Box 1719, Kill Devil Hills, NC 27948, or by e-mail to: odell@kdhnc.com. Electronically submitted comments must include your name and address and should be limited to three minutes when read aloud.

Written objections, comments, or statements of support can also be submitted to the Division of Coastal Management's District Planner, Ms. Charlan Owens, 401 South Griffin Street, Suite 300, Elizabeth City, NC 27909, no more than 30 calendar days after local adoption of the plan. Further information can be obtained by contacting the District Planner at 252-264-3901.

Copies of the CAMA Plan are available for review by the public at the Kill Devil Hills Town Clerk's office, 102 Town Hall Drive, during normal office hours. Following the public hearing, the Board of Commissioners will consider adoption of the CAMA Plan, and action can include approval, disapproval, or tabling the item for further consideration. Once adopted, the plan will be submitted to the Coastal Resources Commission for certification.
