Issues that may be considered include but are not limited to: commercial or residential property categories, overall footprint/impact of building(s); public access to the beach; beach populations; social and economic impacts, and provision services in Kill Devil Hills; comparisons to other communities; and portion of Kill Devil Hills tax base close to the ocean and risk of property loss.
