After years of development, *Great Food and Great Memories* is finally complete. Just as a recipe takes you from raw ingredients to a finished product, so does the cookbook take you through some of the ingredients that went into the soup that became the Town of Kill Devil Hills. Not only are there scrumptious recipes (Like lemon cake? You'll never find one better than Goldie Meekins' Old-Fashion Lemon Cake!) there are also photos, personal stories and

anecdotes, as well as recollections from public documents. Never heard of Ed St. Clair, or Walter Perry? They're both in there.

At their March 25, 2009 meeting the Board of Commissioners authorized a price of \$25, plus \$1.55 tax, for each book, for a total of \$26.55. Arrangements can be made to have *Great Food, Great Memories* shipped for an additional cost, depending on the ZIP code it's going to. Of the purchase price, \$20 is set aside for reprinting the volume and \$5 will be put into the Wallace H. McCown Scholarship Fund which is administered by the Outer Banks Community Foundation.
