

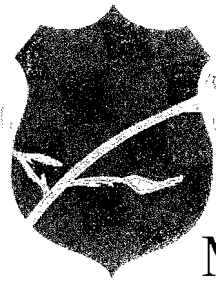
We as law enforcement officers make every effort to memorialize those that have paid the price in the line of duty by never forgetting them.
