Minutes of the Monday, April 13, 2015 regular meeting of the Kill Devil Hills Board of Commissioners held at 5:30 o'clock p.m. in the Meeting Room at the Administration Building, 102 Town Hall Drive, off Colington Road.

Call to Order

At 5:31 p.m., Mayor Davies called this meeting of the Kill Devil Hills Board of Commissioners to order and welcomed all present.

Pledge of Allegiance and Moment of Silence

Mayor Davies asked all to remember Town staff member Dale Bliss in their thoughts this evening as he recently lost his brother.

Agenda Approval

Commissioner Hogan made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to approve the agenda for this meeting as submitted and Commissioner Appleman seconded that motion. Approval was unanimous, 5-0.

Public Hearing

Town Attorney Steve Michael read aloud the rules of procedure for this public hearing and at the conclusion of the procedural guide, he called the public hearing to order. He announced that the public hearing was called for the Board of Commissioners to receive public comment, both written and oral, on the proposed beach nourishment municipal service district and the proposed service to be provided within the municipal service district and adoption of the resolution establishing the municipal service district.

- 1. Proposed beach nourishment municipal service district and the proposed service to be provided within the municipal service district and adoption of resolution establishing municipal service district (Attached PH-1)**

This public hearing was scheduled at the February 9, 2015 meeting and notification procedures comply with the requirements contained in Article 23 of Chapter 160A of the North Carolina General Statutes, which establishes the procedures and conditions under which a town or city may establish a municipal service district (MSD). The first purpose for which an MSD may be established is for *beach erosion control and flood and hurricane protection works*.

The packet materials for this item included written comments regarding beach nourishment received since publication of the public hearing notice, and a copy of the materials sent to all property owners shown on the map of Kill Devil Hills' proposed Beach Nourishment Municipal Service District:

- the report on this project, which includes the statement regarding service proposed to be provided within the MSD, and the plan for providing the proposed service;
- the notice of the public hearing;
- the certification from the Town Clerk regarding the mailing; and;
- the Resolution Establishing and Creating the Kill Devil Hills Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District.

A copy of the actual list of property owners to whom the notification was mailed is filed with the original meeting packet for permanent record.

Staff recommended the Board of Commissioners adopt the Resolution Establishing and Creating the Kill Devil Hills Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District as presented, and a motion will be in order.

Norm Shearin, Vandeventer Black LLP, Southern Shores: Mr. Shearin explained that he was speaking on behalf of Myra Neal Morrison. His comments focused on the legal effect on the property rights of the beach nourishment project, and the MSD. The project report, he stated, says that the property owners within the district would benefit from the beach nourishment project. That is not true in Ms. Morrison's case as her oceanfront property has been stable and not experienced much erosion. The major beneficiaries of the project will be the public, not the private landowners. Copies of the statutes Mr. Shearin referred to during his comments are filed with the minutes of this meeting.

Mr. Shearin explained that prior to the beach nourishment project beginning, the extent of private property rights on the oceanfront is the mean high water mark. Once sand is placed on the beach, however, then it will all become state-owned property. Private property owners may have owned their property for many years, the public will acquire rights and there will even be secondary easements so the public can cross now-private property to the beachfront. Mr. Shearin stated that he wanted the Board of Commissioners to be informed about the consequences of the beach nourishment project.

Mr. Shearin stated that it would be necessary for the Town to acquire easements from private property owners in order to place sand on private property beaches. The easements will be public in nature. The project will be paid for with public funds. The Town of Kill Devil Hills has no rights to the public trust beach – only the State does and therefore the standing to enforce the public trust rights. The public, he added, does not own the entirety of the oceanfront, and he

stated that is not the case. When sand is placed on the oceanfront through a publicly financed project, private property owners will lose their littoral and riparian rights and no longer have direct access to the ocean.

Mr. Shearin stated that there are areas in Kill Devil Hills he feels needs beach nourishment, but Ms. Morrison's property is not one of them. Ms. Morrison will not voluntarily grant the Town the necessary easement for the beach nourishment project and therefore it will need to be obtained by condemnation by the Town. Ms. Morrison also asked Mr. Shearin to communicate her desire for the Board of Commissioners to lower the tax rate.

Phil Hobbs, President, Gulf Stream Owners Property Owners Association, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Hobbs written comments are included with the minutes of this meeting.

Mr. Hobbs stated that he has owned a condominium in Kill Devil Hills for 22 years. He explained that having reviewed the Town's beach nourishment video, and conducting additional research on the matter, there are still concerns and questions, which are summarized as follows:

1. How was the proposed tax rate in the municipal service district calculated? What is the definition of the municipal service district? The proposed rate is 11-times higher than that for the rest of the Town.
2. How long will the tax rate be in place and what will happen in the event that there are extra revenues generated by the tax?
3. Why is the taper area within the MSD taxed at \$.33 per \$100 valuation of property? The taper for the project ends with the Gulf Stream Condominiums property; why was the taper area changed? Kill Devil Hills already has one of the highest tax rates in Dare County. Property owners within the taper request they not be charged the full \$.33 tax rate since there is already a stable beach in place, and they will not get the full benefit of the nourishment project.
4. The greater tax burden is placed on oceanfront property owners who live outside of Kill Devil Hills and therefore have no vote in Dare County. It seems the out-of-town property owners are only for convenience – put the tax on the out-of-towners and let them pay, they cannot vote.
5. How does the occupancy tax figure into the financing of the beach nourishment project? What was the original purpose of the occupancy tax; how is it being used?
6. If the MSD is approved at this meeting, will the tax rate and taper zone be set, or can either the rate or the boundaries of the MSD be changed at a later date?
7. Is there a conflict of interest? Mr. Hobbs stated it appears the beach nourishment project is actually for the benefit of certain groups or establishments and not the individual beachfront owners.

8. If the bids for the beach nourishment project are higher than anticipated, will the taper move?

Mr. Hobbs stated that a neighbor of his will be offering an optional financing plan for the project and hoped the Board of Commissioners would consider it. He also asked the Board to consider moving the taper area, again, and also consider lowering the tax rate for the people in the taper area since they will only be getting about 10 feet of nourishing sand, as opposed to the full amount properties outside the taper will get.

Donna Bohon, 1019 North Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Ms. Bohon's written statement is included with the minutes of this meeting.

Ms. Bohon and her husband have owned the above-referenced property for 17 years, along with two other properties in Kill Devil Hills. They are interested in the beach nourishment project, but are concerned that as out-of-town property owners they have had little input on the proposed MSD tax and how the tax was calculated.

Addressing Kill Devil Hills' beach nourishment video, Ms. Bohon stated that it clearly emphasizes that the beach drives tourism, which increases the area's overall economy. How, she wondered, did the Board arrive at the proposed tax rate within the MSD, which comprises 8% of Kill Devil Hills, and a \$.03 increase for the other 92% of Kill Devil Hills?

Ms. Bohon felt the proposed tax rate(s) to be outrageous and she felt that if the oceanfront drives up tourism then the Board should consider giving the MSD property owners a break and distribute the tax more evenly.

Margaret Long, 1023 North Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mrs. Long explained that she has been a summer resident of Kill Devil Hills for 79 years. Her property, which is 100 feet in width, is within the taper area, and she wondered if there would be a more reasonable solution to taxation within the taper area. She stated that she did not understand why the taper was moved; that she had no objections to beach nourishment, but did desire an explanation on the inequity of the proposed taxes. Oceanfront property owners, Ms. Long stated, have done nothing but help the beach grow. She concluded her comments by stating that she had no desire to be chased off the beach.

Charles Hinton, member/manager 1101 N. Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Hinton related his family's history with Kill Devil Hills and explained that their property is not a rental, but kept for family use. He commended the Board for considering the beach nourishment project, as those oceanfront properties in the northern beach area of Kill Devil Hills need nourishment, but, he added, the beach in front of his family's property is stable and building. This area is very busy and often his family must "stake out" a place in order to be able to enjoy the beach and ocean.

The video on beach nourishment stresses the economics of our area's dependency on the ocean and beach. How then, Mr. Hinton asked, is the proposed tax rate fair? Those that benefit the most from beach nourishment are the businesses. He felt the tax rate to be arbitrary rather

than equitable. In addition, also, he stated, the properties within the taper that will get less sand are being taxed at the same rate as the properties that will get the full benefit of the project.

Since his property doesn't need beach nourishment and it may be a violation of the General Statutes to require it to be in the MSD.

He concluded his comments by reiterating that he felt the tax to be more arbitrary than equitable. The Board's packet memorandum on this item included a recommendation from the Town Manager for approval of the MSD; however, the public hearing notice indicated that changes to the MSD could be made as result of the public hearing. Mr. Hinton felt this statement to be indicative that a decision on the matter had already been made. Mr. Hinton asked the Board to not rush to judgment and to think this matter through and be fair in their decision-making.

Albert Gard, 1201 N. Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Gard's written comments are included with the minutes of this meeting.

Mr. Gard pointed out that the packet memorandum was posted on-line at least two days prior to this meeting, yet is dated for today; the memo has caused concern among a number of people, some of whom are in attendance at this meeting. Mr. Gard explained that his family has owned the oceanfront property on North Virginia Dare Trail since 1936 and that they have a long history in other parts of Dare County, as well.

Mr. Gard read aloud his comments, which are summarized below:

1. Concern: The \$.33 proposed tax rate increase in the MSD, which is 11-times higher than the tax rate for all other areas of Kill Devil Hills, is outrageous and poses a conflict of interest for those members of the Board who live in the remainder of Kill Devil Hills.

Solution: There is a two-penny solution – add two cents to the proposed three-cent tax increase for non-MSD properties, which will result in an 11-cent rate for properties within the MSD. That would be more equitable for all taxpayers and significantly mitigate the Board's "...conflict of interest and professional ethics issue."

2. Concern: As configured, the MSD includes the beach south of Tanya Drive, which according to the Town's engineer is stable and not in need of beach nourishment, which does not comply with statutory requirements for establishing an MSD.

Solution: Stop the MSD at Tanya Drive. The Board of Commissioners, he stated, approved the MSD to stop at Tanya Drive in 2013.

3. Concern: As structured, the proposed funding plan prevents taxpayers from making long-term financial plans – the tax rate could be changed and real estate assessed values can and will change. Additionally, future costs for beach nourishment cannot be estimated.

Solution: Establish a funding plan that includes: fixed tax bills for five years, which is the length of the debt service period (except that, property value can increase should additions be

made, or decrease as a result of individuals improving their properties.) Taxes collected would be solely used for initial construction debt service. In five years, the Town would have some idea as to whether or not the beach nourishment project was successful.

4. Concern: Prior to this meeting, a memorandum was signed by the Town Manager recommending the Board of Commissioners approve the proposed MSD. Mr. Gard felt the Board was not receiving prudent advice.

Solution: Do not vote on the matter at this meeting.

Mr. Gard asked the Board to give careful consideration to the issue(s) and the solutions he presented this evening.

Raymond Murray, 2028 N. Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Murray stated that visitors to Kill Devil Hills use his property on the oceanfront every day to make their way to the beach. If he and his family don't get to the beach early in the morning, they find themselves having to fight to find a place – but actually, they don't go to the beach very often.

In the beach nourishment project report, Mr. Murray explained that his is one of seven houses on the west side of Virginia Dare Trail that are included in the MSD and being charged the same rate as the oceanfront properties. property on the oceanfront is only about 20 feet wide and nothing can be built on it. Mr. Murray recognized that he pays taxes on the oceanfront parcel for the benefit of sitting on his porch and looking at unobstructed views of the ocean.

Both the house and the vacant oceanfront portion of his property will be charged 33 cents based on the proposed municipal service district. He felt that to be unfair. Mr. Murray proposed to pay the 33-cent increase on the small, oceanfront parcel, and pay the 3-cent increase on his west-of-NC 12 property, the same as the other west side properties on NC 12.

Robert Reisse, 2807 Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil HillsHis family are residents of Virginia, they do not live in Kill Devil Hills, nor do they rent their home. As out-of-state residents, they have no say in elections. The proposed tax rate is extremely high and he felt it to be unfair. They do not spend a lot of time at the beach, perhaps a couple of months per year.

Mr. Reisse explained that beach nourishment would benefit rental properties on the west side of NC 12 in a similar manner to those on the oceanfront. West side owners will be able to rent their houses for more because there will be more beach on the east side. West side beach goers use his property to get to the beach.

Out-of-town property owners are being taxed without representation, oceanfront property owners are being overcharged as people across the street use their same beaches and are able to make a profit on the rentals.

Mr. Reisse suggested that all rental properties be charged for the implementation of beach nourishment.

Written Statements Submitted after the Public Hearing Notice was Mailed, and Made a Part of the Record of this Meeting

Dirk Murray, 2028 N. Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Murray submitted an e-mail inquiry on Monday, March 23, 2015 . He asked how the decision to include the seven properties (mentioned earlier in this meeting by Mr. Raymond Murray) came to be included in the MSD. What part of those properties are being taxed at the proposed \$.33 increase – the entire property or just the property on the beach side?

(This e-mail was directed to Planning Director Greg Loy who responded to Mr. Murray by telephone. Mr. Murray indicated his interest in the public hearing and expressed a desire to attend.)

Frank Hicks, 2703 North Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Hicks submitted an e-mail statement in favor of the beach nourishment project and indicated he would like to see it implemented soon. As a cost offset, Mr. Hicks suggested the beach be more friendly to entertainment venues that would generate extra money for the Town.

Mr. Hicks also suggested that once the project is completed that beach driving should be prohibited as it takes a toll on the sand, and people walking on the beach.

(Mr. Hicks e-mail was responded to by the Town Clerk.)

Frances Morris, 3201 North Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Ms. Morris returned a copy of her notification letter and noted her support for the beach nourishment proposal. She also complimented the Town for doing a wonderful job.

Mr. Michael called for additional public speakers, and then made a final call for comments, and asked the Board if they had any questions or comments before the public hearing was closed.

Mayor Davies asked Planning Director Greg Loy to explain how and why the location of the taper was changed. Mr. Loy explained that the change in the taper was recommended by the Town's engineering team. He added that for any project there would always be a taper. Commissioner Appleman confirmed that there is only one taper in Kill Devil Hills and the Town Manager responded that was correct, and if Kitty Hawk were to choose to forego beach nourishment at this time, then Kill Devil Hills would have a north-end taper, as well.

There were no other comments offered at this time and Mr. Michael explained that if the Board members desired to make comments or ask questions of Staff about what they have heard during the public hearing, then he recommended the public hearing remain open. The Board agreed to keep the public hearing open at this time.

Mayor Davies called for discussion or comments from the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Midgette stated that it was interesting to hear the comments from oceanfront property owners – hearing about people using their property to access the beach provided a viewpoint he had not previously considered. However, the Town has no remedy for that situation and Commissioner Hogan interjected that such actions would be a civil matter between the property owners and those using their property without permission.

Commissioner Rheubottom commented that many of the issues raised this evening were related to the taper zone. The comments made a lot of sense and lead Commissioner

Rheubottom to realize the differences in the amount of sand that would be received by properties within the taper as opposed to those oceanfront properties to the north of the taper zone. Commissioner Rheubottom added, she felt that regardless of where the taper is, somebody would be unhappy.

In response to a question from Commissioner Midgette, Mr. Michael explained that the tax rate within the MSD had to be the same amount for all property owners. The taper zone properties could be taken out of the MSD, but that would mean they would benefit from the beach nourishment project without having to pay for those benefits.

Mayor Davies stated that a number of the comments during the public hearing included statements about equity and fairness and questions on how the tax rate was calculated. She explained that shifting the greater tax burden of paying for the project to the oceanfront properties is because of the value the sand has in protecting the property. Kill Devil Hills is trying to protect infrastructure improvements and private properties. The Town is home to a majority of the working class in Dare County. Kill Devil Hills is known to be more affordable. She explained that the Board's job is to look out for all of the stakeholders in Kill Devil Hills – out-of-town property owners and those working to provide all of the services to our visitors and citizens. Additionally, she said, while Kill Devil Hills has a higher ad valorem tax rate than other Dare County municipalities, the services Kill Devil Hills provides are different, and sometimes at a higher level – such as with respect to animal control services.

Mayor Davies said that while some might perceive the rate as inequitable, she assured everyone there is no conflict of interest from any member of the Board of Commissioners in the beach nourishment project. The Board is strictly guided on ethics and the decision-making process by the General Assembly and North Carolina School of Government.

Addressing Mr. Murray's comments, Mayor Davies asked for some assistance in understanding how the seven residential properties were platted with part of each property on the east side and the rest on the west side of NC 12. Mr. Loy explained that when the ClayDon Motel washed into the ocean some years ago, the owner of the motel site and the seven property on the west side of NC 12 came to the Town with a plat that laid out the seven lots. Each lot needed to be at least 15,000 square feet to be buildable and to meet that requirement, each was platted showing a majority of the square footage on the west side and the remainder on the east. The subdivision was platted with each lot being configured as it is today; they are forever tied by the subdivision approval. Today, those seven lots do not meet the 15, 000 square foot requirement due to erosion on the oceanfront.

There being no further comments from the Board at this time, Mr. Michael recognized another public speaker.

Dirk Murray, 2028 N. Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Murray explained that he is Raymond Murray's son. He offered a different calculation for the tax on the 7 properties on the west side of NC 12, suggesting that if, for example, four houses could be built on the east side properties then that value could be used as a base on which to calculate the taxes for all seven properties.

He also pointed out that properties on the west side of NC 12 will be receiving benefits without having to pay the large amount oceanfront property owners must pay. He asked the Board to consider proration of taxes for these properties.

Commissioner Appleman asked Mr. Loy about the four-house concept Mr. Murray proposed, and explained that he was trying to figure out how the four-house idea could be used when there is not enough property there to build even one. Mr. Loy explained there is no remedy to prorate the taxes if the property is within the district, except to take it out. Mayor Davies reminded that the Board does not have the authority to charge a different rate for any property within the proposed municipal service district.

Commissioner Rheubottom explained that when beach nourishment was first in the discussion stages she had not supported the concept. Of particular concern was the expense of such a huge project and the financial impacts (taxation) it would have on the property owners in Kill Devil Hills. There are a lot of people in Town that are part of the middle class and she was concerned that if beach nourishment were pursued there would be many people who could no longer afford to live here. Over time, however, and with more information, she came to realize the importance of, and need for, the project. She emphasized that she understood the comments from the speakers. She did not believe most of the property owners were against beach nourishment, but the problem is finding an equitable way to implement it. Commissioner Rheubottom stated that she felt it important that the Board be united on the beach nourishment project. She added for the benefit of all that she would do her best, and knew the Board of Commissioners would do its best, to keep costs down and assure the project is completed to the best of its ability.

Betsy Birdsong, 1207 Windsong Way, Kill Devil Hills: Ms. Birdsong stated that Windsong Way is the only cul-de-sac in the zone, and there are a number of properties there that are not oceanfront, but are included within the MSD. She asked for a different way to tax those properties that were not oceanfront.

Dana Reisse, 2807 Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Ms. Reisse felt that taxing only a few people, when all of Kill Devil Hills will benefit from improvements to the Town's oceanfront, to be totally unfair. She explained that very often she finds people using her property – her porch, the steps, etc. Everybody uses “her” beach, she explained, and it seems unfair to tax oceanfront property owners as if they were the owners of private property when there is no private beach and little overall privacy. Ms. Reisse concluded by stating that she did not understand why the tax rate could not be more equally applied to all properties in Kill Devil Hills.

Carolyn Gard, 1201 N. Virginia Dare Trail, Kill Devil Hills: Ms. Gard stated that the Town's engineers for the beach nourishment project have said that from Tanya Drive, south, beach nourishment is not needed. It is unfair to tax oceanfront properties at such an exorbitant rate when everyone in Kill Devil Hills will benefit from the beach nourishment project.

Ms. Gard described the difficulties she has going to the beach even though she owns oceanfront property: so many people are on the beach that one has to go out really early in the morning to claim a space, or you have to walk a long way to find someplace to put down a towel.

Gene Winton, 1223 Windsong Way, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Winton explained that eight of the neighbors in the Windsong Way cul-de-sac are not oceanfront property owners. His property is not oceanfront. When they retired, Mr. Winton explained that he and his wife became residents of Kill Devil Hills. He asked the Board for reconsideration on the proposed tax rate for the MSD.

Ann Segaloff, 1219 Windsong Way, Kill Devil Hills: Ms. Segaloff indicated that she has owned her oceanfront property on Windsong Way for approximately 20 years. Since 2002, approximately 94 feet of beach has eroded in front of her property. She stated that she does not want to lose her life's investment/children's inheritance. The benefits of beach nourishment will be enjoyed by everyone, Ms. Segaloff explained, and she asked the Board of Commissioners to reconsider the proposed tax rate.

She also related problems she has experienced with respect to people using her private property without permission, including people showering on her deck.

Skip Jones, 1508 Captain's Lane, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. Jones explained that he has lived in Kill Devil Hills since the mid-1970s. He stated that property values are going to increase for oceanfront property owners because of the improved beaches that will be constructed in front of their properties. Mr. Jones agreed with some of the comments made during the public hearing, particularly that there is a big difference in the proposed \$.03 tax increase for most of Kill Devil Hills' properties, and the \$.33 increase for beach nourishment that will be paid by those property owners in the MSD.

Mr. Jones suggested the Board of Commissioners give more time for consideration of the comments, and thought that the issue might require additional conversation on the matter after the public hearing is concluded.

Mr. Michael called for any further comments and there were none.

The Board confirmed with Mr. Michael that the tax rate for the district does not have to be set at this time; it can be set when the budget for the project is established. Mayor Davies also confirmed that there is a significant financial benefit to keeping Kill Devil Hills, Kitty Hawk and Duck's beach nourishment projects on the same schedule.

Mr. Michael closed the public hearing.

Mayor Davies stated that there would be renourishment projects in the future, perhaps between 5-7 years after the initial project. The Board considers what the tax rate for the Town needs to be every year, and that will be the same when considering future nourishment projects.

Commissioner Midgette felt it important for Kill Devil Hills to move forward with the beach nourishment project as he did not want the Town to lose as much beach as Kitty Hawk has lost over many years. Commissioner Hogan agreed and stated that he would hate to see such a loss happen to anyone in Kill Devil Hills and without taking the steps to move forward with

beach nourishment, it could happen. The tax rate may yet be a matter of discussion, but Commissioner Hogan explained that whether or not to move forward with the project is not a matter of discussion for him – he has supported the beach nourishment project for some time.

Mayor Davies explained that the Board's packet memorandums always reflect the date of the meeting at which they are being presented. Staff spends time with issues, studying them, and responding to the Board's expectations that recommendations are made and made based on factual information. How the memos were presented for this meeting is consistent with how the Town operates.

Commissioner Hogan made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to adopt the Resolution Establishing and Creating the Kill Devil Hills Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District. Commissioner Midgette seconded that motion. Approval was by unanimous vote, 5-0.

Mayor Davies explained that the tax rate would be discussed more as the Board moves forward in the budget process.

At 6:55 p.m. Mayor Davies called for a brief break in proceedings. The meeting resumed at 6:58 p.m.

Public Comment (Time limit of 3 minutes per person; 5 minutes per group)

Donnie King, Ocean Boulevard Restaurant, Kitty Hawk: Mr. King commended the Board for moving forward with beach nourishment.

Jack McCombs, 917 Cedar Drive, Kill Devil Hills: Mr. McCombs addressed the issue of cycling safety. He had a recent incident with a motorist who deliberately passed extremely closely to him. Mr. McCombs contacted Chief Gary Britt, who responded by letter to Mr. McCombs, and who sent an officer to explain the law to the motorist.

Another incident involved a fellow cyclist from Wisconsin who felt our town to be, generally, against cyclists. Mr. McCombs assured this person that was not the case.

Cyclists contribute \$60 million in revenues in North Carolina and Mr. McCombs cautioned that it is important for the Outer Banks community to welcome cyclists and promote cycling safety.

Response to Public Comment

Introductions and Presentations

1. Representatives of the Outer Banks Visitors Bureau presentation on tourism and its impact to Dare County

Outer Banks Visitors Bureau Executive Director Lee Nettles and Dare County Tourism Board Chairman Tim Cafferty conducted a PowerPoint presentation, which is included with the packet materials for this meeting, and provided information on the Tourism Board, economic

statistics on Dare County's occupancy tax revenues, and on the potential of offshore oil drilling and natural gas exploration.

Old Business

1. Beach driving (Attached OB-1)

At their meeting on April 1st, the Nags Head Board of Commissioners reacted favorably to the possibility of establishing a reciprocal agreement with the Town of Kill Devil Hills whereby a beach driving permit issued in either town would be recognized by the other.

The Town Attorney recommended development of a reciprocal agreement to finalize this arrangement.

The packet materials for this item included the latest version of Kill Devil Hills' draft of the new Chapter 96, Seaside Regulations. Staff recommended the ordinance include the underlined language on Page 5, §96.21, Permits, b(1), which incorporated tackle shops designated by the Town of Nags Head as appropriate locations for beach driving permit issuance.

At Kill Devil Hills' March 9th meeting, the Board indicated a desire to hold a public hearing on the draft ordinance. Mayor Davies explained that the Board will conduct a public forum on Wednesday, April 29th, which will be an opportunity for citizens to address the Board on any matter. Mayor Davies asked if the Board would like to include beach driving as a specific topic for the public forum, or would they prefer to move forward with the public hearing. She added that at this time, based on favorable comments from the public, and the lack of negative input date, the proposed beach driving regulations seem to be well received.

As recommended, Commissioner Appleman made a motion for the Board to direct the Town Attorney to work with the Town Attorney for Nags Head to develop the necessary reciprocal agreement for the issuance of beach driving permits. Commissioner Rheubottom seconded that motion and approval was unanimous, 5-0.

The Board of Commissioners agreed that the public forum to be a good venue at which to hear from the public on the proposed beach driving regulations and a special notice will be developed.

New Business

1. Beach nourishment agreements (Attached NB-1A and 1B)

A. Interlocal agreement with Dare County

This agreement has been approved by the County of Dare and the Towns of Kitty Hawk and Duck. It puts in writing the understanding of all parties as the beach nourishment project(s) move forward. Under the terms of the agreement, the towns will continue to make all of the decisions, and handle all public inquiries, press releases and other requests for information concerning their respective projects, and the dredge contract will be with Dare County. This allows all projects to be placed in one bid, thus ensuring the lowest possible cost for all. Dare

County will continue to manage the funds for the dredge portion of the cumulative projects – each town will deposit its share with the County and the County will pay the dredging contractor. Funding obligations are included in the agreement and should the dredging exceed estimated costs then each town will be responsible to either cut their project or otherwise meet the funding need; in the event the dredging costs are less than anticipated, the savings will stay in the beach nourishment fund for future uses.

This agreement has been reviewed by the Town Attorney and Staff recommended approval of the agreement.

B. Agreement for bond counsel for financing beach nourishment project

This engagement letter set forth the terms and conditions under which Parker Poe Adams & Bernstein, LLP would serve as the Town's bond counsel for financing our portion of the beach nourishment project. No specific fee was included in the agreement, as it is customary for a fixed fee to be established so that it can be included in and paid from the project financing. There are months before financing will occur and the project will continue to develop between now and the financing phase. At the appropriate time in the process, a mutually agreed upon fee will be negotiated; however, having the agreement in place at this time will allow the Town's Finance Director to rely on Parker Poe's experience and expertise as this all moves forward. Note: Parker Poe also participated in drafting the Interlocal agreement in Item NB-1A.

Staff recommended approval of the agreement with Parker Poe Adams & Bernstein, LLC for bond counsel for financing the beach nourishment project as presented, including approval of Budget Amendment #19 in the amount of \$40,000 to provide estimated funding for these services.

Commissioner Hogan made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to approve New Business 1A and 1B, as presented. Commissioner Appleman seconded that motion and approval was unanimous, 5-0.

2. Appointments (Attachments NB-2A, 2B, and 2C)

Appointment histories for potential appointees and membership information for each board listed below was included in the packet materials for this item. Mayor Davies called on Commissioner Hogan for his comments.

A. Historic Landmarks Commission – regular position

A vacancy on the Historic Landmarks Commission was created with the resignation of Dr. Demetri Poulis.

Commissioner Hogan indicated that he had spoken with Mary Simpson and that he recommended her to fill the vacancy on the HLC, with expiration of the existing term in September 2016.

B. Zoning Board of Adjustment – two regular and one alternate positions

The alternate position held by Blake Culpepper, and a regular position held by William E. Donahue, on the Board of Adjustment both will expire in May 2015. In addition, a regular position expires in June 2015 and that seat is held by Joe Agnew. All three members desired to be considered for reappointment to their respective positions.

Commissioner Hogan explained that he recommended each be reappointed to their respective seats on the Board of Adjustment: an alternate term that will expire in May 2018, a regular term that will expire in May 2018, and a regular term that will expire in June 2018, respectively.

C. Dangerous Animal Appeal Board – two regular positions

The regular term on the DAAB that expires in May 2015 is currently held by Christine Stafford. Temple Heggie also holds a regular seat on the DAAB and that term expires in June 2015. Both Ms. Stafford and Ms. Heggie desired to be considered for reappointment to these positions.

Commissioner Hogan explained that he also recommended the Board reappoint Ms. Stafford and Ms. Heggie to the DAAB; Ms. Stafford for a three-year term that will expire in May 2018, and Ms. Heggie, also for three years, to expire in June 2018, respectively.

Commissioner Hogan made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to approve the recommendations for appointment he made in NB-2A, 2B, and 2C. Commissioner Rheubottom seconded that motion, and approval was unanimous, 5-0.

3. Position Classification and Pay Study – Becky Veazey, MAPS Group

Becky Veazey of the MAPS Group was present to provide the Board with information and the recommendations her company has made in the recently conducted Personnel Classification and Pay Study, including implementation options.

A PowerPoint program was conducted that established her company's qualifications to conduct the study, and reviewed the methodology used to complete the study. Using specific examples, Ms. Veazey explained how changes in position classifications came to be recommended, which also included recommendations in changes in salaries for certain, not all, positions. A notebook that contained the classification and salary study, and the recommended changes to the Town's Personnel Policy was distributed to the Board of Commissioners by Ms. Veazey. The classification and salary study resulted in two implementation strategies, Ms. Veazey explained, and she recommended the Board consider the second implementation strategy as it will do more to correct the salaries of the employees most underpaid, and also do more to relieve the salaries compression throughout the Town's employees. She reviewed the organization of the notebook and at the conclusion of her comments, Ms. Veazey offered to come to a future meeting to conduct a worksession with the Board, if it was desired, and also offered to answer any questions the Board might have at this time.

Mayor Davies and the Board of Commissioners thanked her for her presentation and comments and indicated that if necessary they would ask Ms. Veazey to return. This item will be scheduled for consideration at a later date.

Commissioners' Agenda

Commissioner Midgette

- Fishing in the Fresh Pond. Commissioner Midgette explained that he has received requests from persons desiring to fish in the Fresh Pond. Mayor Davies responded that she had recently met with Staff on this matter and found out that the Town of Nags Head still maintains the Fresh Pond as a backup fresh water source. As it is a fresh water source, no fishing would be allowed in the pond. Additional research is going to be conducted to determine whether or not options may be considered and additional information will be provided as it becomes available.

Commissioner Rheubottom

- Outer Banks Senior Games. The games begin this week and she extended an open invitation to all to attend.

Mayor's Agenda

1. Resolution Opposing NC SB 369 – sales tax redistribution (Attached MA-1)

Under current rules, more sales tax revenue, generally 75 percent, goes back to the counties where goods are sold and 25 percent is distributed among counties based on population. However, proposed SB 369 shifts the distribution entirely to population-based, which would greatly impact Kill Devil Hills and other resort communities and “shopping areas” in North Carolina. The formula using population does not consider second-home residents or tourists. Raising property taxes to the extent necessary to make up for such a dramatic change in revenues distribution could potentially mean an annual tax increase of \$49 for every \$100,000 of assessed property value.

Mayor Davies recommend the Board of Commissioners adopt the attached resolution opposing SB 369, which, upon adoption, will be shared with all Dare County local governments, our state representatives in the North Carolina legislature, the NC League of Municipalities, distributed through the Town's social media and placed on Town bulletin boards.

Mayor Davies made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to adopt the Resolution Opposing NC SB 369 – sales tax redistribution and Commissioner Appleman seconded that motion. Approval was unanimous, 5-0.

2. Week of the Young Child (Attached MA-2)

The Week of the Young Child is an annual celebration sponsored by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), the world's largest early childhood

education association, with nearly 80,000 members and a network of over 300 local, state, and regional Affiliates.

The purpose of the Week of the Young Child is to focus public attention on the needs of young children and their families and to recognize the early childhood programs and services that meet those needs.

NAEYC first established the Week of the Young Child in 1971, recognizing that the early childhood years (birth through age 8) lay the foundation for children's success in school and later life. The Week of the Young Child is a time to plan how we can better meet the needs of all young children and their families.

Mayor Davies made a motion for the Board of Commissioners adopt the proclamation celebrating the "Week of the Young Child," which will be shared with appropriate local organizations, through the Town's social media, and electronic distribution to our citizens and local news media, including the Dare County local governments. Commissioner Rheubottom seconded that motion and approval was unanimous, 5-0.

3. Earth Day 2015 Proclamation (Attached MA-3)

Earth Day began in 1970 as an event to gather national support for environmental issues. Today, Earth Day is celebrated worldwide by more than 1 billion people in 192 countries as a date to increase awareness on important environmental issues and encourage green and sustainable practices, activities, and programs.

April 22, 2015 will be the 45th anniversary of Earth Day and following are some activities our citizens and visitors can practice with their family and friends to celebrate our Earth:

- Plant new trees.
- Participate in outdoor activities with your family such as making homes for local wildlife and discuss their roles in the ecosystem.
- Teach your children about the recycling and reuse of the old materials.
- Take part in picking up litter from streets, parks and other places.
- Take part in educational sessions like seminars, discussions and other activities related to the safety of natural resources of the earth.
- Motivate people by wearing green, brown or blue clothes to display the environmental colors.
- Promote energy conservation by various practical means.
- Teach people that every day of their life is earth day, so they should take care of the earth on a daily basis.

Mayor Davies made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to adopt the Earth Day 2015 Proclamation as presented. Commissioner Hogan seconded that motion and approval was unanimous, 5-0.

4. Resolution in Continued Opposition to Off-Shore Drilling (Attached MA-4)

This resolution was adopted by the Dare County Board of Commissioners at their April 6th meeting. The Kill Devil Hills Board last took action on a similar resolution in June 2014.

Mayor Davies explained that given recent announcements from the federal government, which could authorize offshore drilling and exploration for oil and natural gas, she felt that Kill Devil Hills should reaffirm its position in opposition to offshore drilling.

Mayor Davies made a motion for the Board of Commissioners to adopt the Resolution in Continued Opposition to Off-Shore Drilling, which will be distributed and shared in a manner similar to the other resolutions/proclamations on which action was taken at this meeting. Commissioner Midgette seconded that motion and approval was unanimous, 5-0.

Mayor Davies also announced the following:

- Nancy Miller retired at the end of March, long-time assistant in the Planning Department.
- Jody Long, has been promoted to Fire Captain; and, Carl Hunt, has been promoted to Building Inspector
- The panels are now in place at the KDHWTF, LLC to help diffuse odors coming from the facility.

Mayor Davies also addressed the matter of large single-family dwellings on the oceanfront.

- Single-family dwellings on the oceanfront. Mayor Davies asked the Board if they wanted to make the decision this evening to send this issue to the Planning Board through Staff. She called on Assistant Planning Director Meredith Guns, who presented the Board with information on how other local governments in our area handle extremely large houses. She distributed paper copies of the PowerPoint presentation she made, which has been included with the materials for this meeting. The presentation included several photos of large oceanfront single-family dwellings and Ms. Guns explained that the Town has recently received a building permit application for a 24-bedroom single-family dwelling.

Ms. Guns also explained that there is a bill before the State legislature, which would restrict local government's ability to restrict the number of bedrooms in a single-family dwelling. Control of single-family dwellings will need to be focused on square footage or the actual bulk of the structure, rather than the number of bedrooms since this bill seems to be on its way to approval.

The Board of Commissioners was supportive of sending this matter to the Planning Board for review and recommendation and by consensus approval gave Staff the direction to do so.

- Future Destination Dare on Kill Devil Hills' Community Rating System. Mayor Davies expressed hope that a future Destination Dare segment could include information on Kill Devil Hills' CRS and she was advised that work is already underway to have that done.

Article 3.

Lands Adjoining Coastal Waters.

§ 77-20. Seaward boundary of coastal lands.

(a) The seaward boundary of all property within the State of North Carolina, not owned by the State, which adjoins the ocean, is the mean high water mark. Provided, that this section shall not apply where title below the mean high water mark is or has been specifically granted by the State.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no agency shall issue any rule or regulation which adopts as the seaward boundary of privately owned property any line other than the mean high water mark. The mean high water mark also shall be used as the seaward boundary for determining the area of any property when such determination is necessary to the application of any rule or regulation issued by any agency.

(c) For purposes of this Article, "agency" means any part, branch, division, or instrumentality of the State; any county, municipality, or special district; or any commission, committee, council, or board established by the State, or by any county or municipality.

(d) The public having made frequent, uninterrupted, and unobstructed use of the full width and breadth of the ocean beaches of this State from time immemorial, this section shall not be construed to impair the right of the people to the customary free use and enjoyment of the ocean beaches, which rights remain reserved to the people of this State under the common law and are a part of the common heritage of the State recognized by Article XIV, Section 5 of the Constitution of North Carolina. These public trust rights in the ocean beaches are established in the common law as interpreted and applied by the courts of this State.

(e) As used in this section, "ocean beaches" means the area adjacent to the ocean and ocean inlets that is subject to public trust rights. This area is in constant flux due to the action of wind, waves, tides, and storms and includes the wet sand area of the beach that is subject to regular flooding by tides and the dry sand area of the beach that is subject to occasional flooding by tides, including wind tides other than those resulting from a hurricane or tropical storm. The landward extent of the ocean beaches is established by the common law as interpreted and applied by the courts of this State. Natural indicators of the landward extent of the ocean beaches include, but are not limited to, the first line of stable, natural vegetation; the toe of the frontal dune; and the storm trash line. (1979, c. 618, s. 2; 1998-225, s. 5.1.)

§ 146-6. Title to land raised from navigable water.

(a) If any land is, by any process of nature or as a result of the erection of any pier, jetty or breakwater, raised above the high watermark of any navigable water, title thereto shall vest in the owner of that land which, immediately prior to the raising of the land in question, directly adjoined the navigable water. The tract, title to which is thus vested in a riparian owner, shall include only the front of his formerly riparian tract and shall be confined within extensions of his property lines, which extensions shall be perpendicular to the channel, or main watercourses.

(b) If any land is, by act of man, raised above the high watermark of any navigable water by filling, except such filling be to reclaim lands theretofore lost to the owner by natural causes or as otherwise provided under the proviso of subsection (d), title thereto shall vest in the State and the land so raised shall become a part of the vacant and unappropriated lands of the State, unless the commission of the act which caused the raising of the land in question shall have been previously approved in the manner provided in subsection (c) of this section. Title to land so raised, however, does not vest in the State if the land was raised within the bounds of a conveyance made by the State Board of Education, which included regularly flooded estuarine marshlands or lands beneath navigable waters, or if the land was raised under permits issued to private individuals pursuant to G.S. 113-229, G.S. 113A-100 through 113A-128, or both.

(c) If any owner of land adjoining any navigable water desires to fill in the area immediately in front of his land, he may apply to the Department of Administration for an easement to make such fill. The applicant shall deliver to each owner of riparian property adjoining that of the applicant, a copy of the application filed with the Department of Administration, and each such person shall have 30 days from the date of such service to file with the Department of Administration written objections to the granting of the proposed easement. If the Department of Administration finds that the purpose of the proposed fill is to reclaim lands theretofore lost to the owner by natural causes, no easement to fill shall be required. In such a case the Department shall give the applicant written permission to proceed with the project. If the purpose of the proposed fill is not to reclaim lands lost by natural causes and the Department finds that the proposed fill will not impede navigation or otherwise interfere with the use of the navigable water by the public or injure any adjoining riparian owner, it shall issue to such applicant an easement to fill and shall fix the consideration to be paid for the easement, subject to the approval of the Governor and Council of State in each instance. The granting by the State of the written permission or easement so to fill shall be deemed conclusive evidence and proof that the applicant has complied with all requisite conditions precedent to the issuance of such written permission or easement, and his right shall not thereafter be subject to challenge by reason of any alleged omission on his part. None of the provisions of this section shall relieve any riparian owner of the requirements imposed by the applicable laws and regulations of the United States. Upon completion of such filling, the Governor and Council of State may, upon request, direct the execution of a quitclaim deed therefor to the owner to whom the easement was granted, conveying the land so raised, upon such terms as are deemed proper by the Department and approved by the Governor and Council of State.

(d) If an island is, by any process of nature or by act of man, formed in any navigable water, title to such island shall vest in the State and the island shall become a part of the vacant and unappropriated lands of the State. Provided, however, that if in any process of dredging, by either the State or federal government, for the purpose of deepening any harbor or inland waterway, or clearing out or creating the same, a deposit of the excavated material is made upon the lands of any owner, and title to which at the time is not vested in either the State or federal government, or any other person, whether such excavation be deposited with or without the approval of the owner or owners of such lands, all such additions to lands shall accrue to the use and benefit of the owner or owners of the land or lands on which such deposit shall have been made, and such owner or owners shall be deemed vested in fee simple with the title to the same.

My name is Donna Bohon. My husband and I have owned property for the past 17 years at 1019 N. Va Dare Trail, along with two other properties in KDH, NC. We are very interested in the Beach Nourishment plans, but feel concerned that we as owners have very little say on the amount we are having to pay and how this amount was calculated.

The New Video on Beach Nourishment on the KDH website clearly emphasizes that the beach drives tourism, which in turn drives up the KDH economy and jobs (4000) in KDH, schools the best in NC, health care and public services.

Therefore how did the town council arrive at the 32.09 tax increase for MSD PROPERTY owners (which is 8% of KDH) and a 3 percent increase for the rest of the town (which is 92% of KDH)? The owners of Gulfstream condos have had an increase of 2.25 % over the last 10 years.

Municipal Service District property owners would pay 11 times the tax rate of 92% of the town property owners!!!! Is this not an outrageous amount for MSD owners to pay? Would you reconsider this amount with regard to the oceanfront owners versus the rest of Kill Devil Hill owners? If the beach drives up tourism, then why not consider giving the MSD a break and distribute the amount more evenly over the time frame, 3 cents versus 33 cents.

ISSUES SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDED SOLUTIONS
April 13, 2015**

My name is Albert Gard - I live at 1201 North Virginia Dare Trail. My family has owned the property since 1936 when my parents built a cottage there. My Grandfather was born in Manns Harbor and my ties to the area go back to the 1800's.

You have just heard four major issues regarding the Beach Nourishment Project. I will summarize each briefly and provide suggested solutions for each for your consideration.

Issue # 1 - The 33 cent proposed tax rate for property in the MSD is ELEVEN times that proposed for the rest of the town. That is outrageous and poses a big conflict of interests for each of you who live in the 3-cent area.

THERE IS A TWO PENNY SOLUTION: Add 2 cents to the proposed tax rate for the non-MSD area of KDH. That will result in an 11-cent rate for the MSD (a 32% increase) and a MSD rate over TWICE the total 5-cent rate for rest of the town. Those rates (11 cents for the MSD and 5 cents for the rest of the town) will be substantially more equitable for all tax payers and significantly mitigate your conflict of interests and professional ethics issue.

Issue # 2 - The MSD, as configured, does not comply with statutory requirements for a MSD as it includes the beach south of Tanya Street, which, according to the town's engineering study, is stable and does not need nourishment.

THE SOLUTION -- Stop the southern end of the MSD at Tanya Street.

Issue #3 - The structure of the proposed funding plan does not allow a taxpayer to make long-term financial plans. The tax rate could be changed and underlying real estate assessed values can and will change. Additionally, future nourishment cost cannot be estimated.

THE SOLUTION - Establish a funding plan that includes the following features:

The property owner's tax bill will be fixed for five years except for:

It can increase for the effect of the owner's property additions.

It will decrease as a result of the effect of property additions of others.

Taxes collected will be used solely for initial construction debt service.

Future beach nourishment issues and related cost will be addressed at such time as they occur.

Issue # 4 - Before tonight's public meeting the town manager signed and dated a memorandum to the KDH Mayor and Commissioners recommending you approve the proposed MSD tonight it even states the town staff agrees. That memo distresses many of us presenting tonight and I suspect each of you because you obviously are not receiving careful and diligent advise from those individuals on the issues the public is addressing tonight.

THE SOLUTION -- DO NOT VOTE TONIGHT. Please study and give careful consideration to the issues and suggested solutions we have expressed here tonight.

This letter is in reference to your property in Kill Devil Hills, located at 3201 N VA DARE TRL . Over the past several years the Town of Kill Devil Hills has considered and worked towards the possibility of implementing a beach nourishment project along a portion of the Town's Atlantic Ocean beaches. After careful and thorough consideration, Kill Devil Hills proposes to proceed with a project to build up the oceanfront dune and nourish a portion of our northernmost beaches.

The north-Kill Devil Hills beaches have been in a high erosion cycle for many years. In this area there are many privately owned oceanfront and non-oceanfront properties, and infrastructure improvements that serve property owners both within and outside of this geographical area. The Kill Devil Hills Board of Commissioners is committed to beach nourishment to maintain a wide recreational beach, to protect structures of historic significance, to maintain a tax and economic base, and to protect infrastructure improvements, including facilities for public recreational access.

In order to maintain the aesthetic, environmental, and physical value of the beach, the Board of Commissioners has determined that the creation of a municipal service district for erosion control and flood and hurricane protection works would benefit both public and private property owners. Municipal service districts are special revenue districts with specific boundaries that raise money for specified purposes.

As proposed, Kill Devil Hills' beach nourishment municipal service district is approximately 2.6 miles long. The main fill length stretches from the Kill Devil Hills/Kitty Hawk corporate limits south to Windsong Way. A taper of approximately 1,000 feet will continue from Windsong Way south to Prospect Avenue. The project will receive approximately 911,600 cubic yards, or approximately 70 cubic yards per foot of nourishing sand. The proposed district is in need of projects and programs to a demonstrably greater extent (meeting the needs of NCGS 160A-537[a]) than the remainder of the town in order to meet the needs and goals set forth above. If the municipal service district is approved, an estimated tax rate of \$.33 per \$100 in property valuation

1. The attached map identifies the proposed Municipal Service District.

Total project length is approximately 2.6 miles and includes main fill length from Town of Kill Devil Hills north corporate boundary line to Windsong Way, and tapering approximately 1,000 feet to Prospect Ave., east of North Carolina Highway 12, Virginia Dare Trail. The project will receive approximately 911,600 cubic yards or approximately 70 CY/Ft of nourishing sand.

2. Statement indicating that services are needed in the district to a demonstrably greater extent than the rest of the Town:

The Town is committed to beach nourishment to maintain a wide recreation beach to protect structures of historic significance, to maintain a tax and economic base, and to protect town infrastructure including facilities for public recreational access. In order to maintain the aesthetic and environmental value of the beach strand, the Board of Commissioners for the Town of Kill Devil Hills has determined that the creation of a municipal service district for erosion control and flood and hurricane protection works will be for the benefit of those properties located within the service district boundaries.

The proposed district is in need of projects and programs (meeting the standards of NCGS 160A-537(a)) to a demonstrably greater extent than the remainder of the town in order to meet the needs and goals set forth above.

3. Plan for providing proposed services in the Municipal Service District:

The project entails the dredging and placement of approximately 911,600 cubic yards of beach quality sand along 2.6 miles of northern Kill Devil Hills' beaches. The main portion of the proposed local project begins at the north town limit and extends south to Windsong Way. The length of the main portion of nourished shoreline, excluding the tapers, is 12,588 feet. If the Kill Devil Hills project is constructed as a stand-alone project, two taper sections would be included, one on the south end and the other on the north end of the main placement area. The south taper would end just north of the Prospect Avenue public access (1,009 ft.), while the north taper would extend into the Town of Kitty Hawk, terminating just south of Tateway Road at (912 ft.).

Thus, the Kill Devil Hills project will include 14,509 feet (2.75 mi.) of shoreline. The project will advance the shoreline seaward up to 125 feet depending on the area to be nourished. The sand will be dredged from an approved borrow area between 4.1 and 6.5 miles offshore and deposited on the beach in northern Kill Devil Hills. The MSD area is at greater risk of damage from shoreline retreat and storm surge when compared to the remainder of the Town.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND CREATING THE KILL DEVIL HILLS BEACH EROSION CONTROL AND FLOOD AND HURRICANE WORKS MUNICIPAL SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Chapter 160A, Article 23 of the North Carolina General Statutes authorizes towns within North Carolina to define service districts to finance, provide, or maintain for such districts one or more services facilities, or functions in addition to or to a greater extent than those financed, provided or maintained for the entire city; and

WHEREAS, said statutes further provide that the town may define a service district for the purpose of beach erosion control and flood and hurricane protection works; and

WHEREAS, acting in response to a need for action in order to protect structures of historic significance, to maintain the Town's tax and economic base, protect town infrastructure including facilities for public recreational access, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Kill Devil Hills has determined that the creation of a municipal service district for erosion control and flood and hurricane protection works will be for the benefit of those properties located within the service district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Kill Devil Hills further finds that the district is in need of projects and programs to the standards of NCGS 160A-537(a) to a demonstrably greater extent than the remainder of the town to meet the needs and goals set forth above; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such determinations and in accordance with applicable provision of the General Statutes, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Kill Devil Hills has defined such a district and does determine, as a fact, that the proposed district is in need of one or more of the services, facilities, or functions listed in NCGS 160A-536(a) to a demonstrably greater extent than the remainder of the town; and

WHEREAS, a map of the district showing its proposed boundaries, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, a statement showing that the district meets the standards set out in NCGS 160A-537(a), and a plan for providing in the district one or more of the services listed in NCGS 160A-536 has been created; all of which has been incorporated into a report which has been available for public inspection in the office of the Town Clerk for four (4) weeks prior to the public hearing on the matter of the establishment of the service district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Kill Devil Hills has caused a notice and map of the proposed municipal service district of such hearing to be duly published in the Coastland Times, a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Kill Devil Hills and

Dare County on the 26th day of February 2015, and the 12th and 26th days of March 2015 said hearing having been conducted on April 13, 2015, and the Town Clerk has certified to the Board of Commissioners that the mailing of notice of the public hearing has been completed, all in conformity to NGS 160A-537(c).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE TOWN OF KILL DEVIL HILLS, NORTH CAROLINA, that:

1. The Town of Kill Devil Hills has fully complied with each and every requirement of Chapter 160A, Article 23 of the North Carolina General Statutes and determines and finds same as a fact.
2. The Kill Devil Hills Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District for erosion control and flood and hurricane works is hereby established and created in accordance with the following description:

Contained within the Atlantic Ocean to the east, North Carolina Highway 12 to the west, Town of Kitty Hawk corporate line to the north, and Prospect Avenue to the south and being the same property as shown within the boundaries set forth on that certain map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, to which reference is made for a more complete and accurate description of the boundaries of the Kill Devil Hills Beach Erosion Control and Flood and Hurricane Works Municipal Service District.

3. The Town of Kill Devil Hills may levy property taxes within the service district in addition to those throughout the town in order to finance, provide or maintain for the district, services provided therein, in addition to or to a greater extent than those financed, provided or maintained for the entire town.
4. This resolution shall take effect at the beginning of fiscal year 2015-2016.
