A RESOLUTION OF CONTINUED PARTNERSHIP WITH THE WRIGHT BROTHERS NATIONAL MEMORIAL AND ITS GENERAL PLAN

WHEREAS, the Wright Brothers National Memorial and accompanying grounds are within the corporate limits of the Town of Kill Devil Hills, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Kill Devil Hills, since its incorporation in 1953, considers the Wright Brothers National Memorial a part of its heritage and identity; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service, which operates the Wright Brothers National Memorial, and the Town of Kill Devil Hills desire to reaffirm our partnership; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service has previously sought input from the Town of Kill Devil Hills in its General Plans for the Wright Brothers National Memorial, which sets out a vision for the facility's long-term development and opportunities for the community and nation;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina, adopts the following language recommended by the National Park Service for inclusion in the General Plan for the Wright Brothers National Memorial:

“The Town of Kill Devil Hills moves to engage in discussions with the National Park Service related to designing and permitting a beach parking area on the east side of the National Park Service's property located on Prospect Avenue.”
