Arrests:

Assault with a Deadly Weapon: On August 9, 2020 Kill Devil Hills Police were dispatched to a 911 call concerning a shooting incident in the 300 block of West Third Street. Officers responded to the scene and found a male suffering from a gun shot wound. Based on information gathered during the investigation a suspect was identified and charged with Assault With a Deadly Weapon Inflicting Serious Injury.

Indecent Exposure: On August 12, 2020, officers responded to a call for indecent exposure and a suspicious male. Upon arrival officers investigated the incident and arrested a male for Indecent Exposure, Injury to Property, and Resist, Delay, and Obstruct.

Cases

August 2, 2020: Officers responded to a overdose on Fentanyl of two individuals at a motel in the 800 block of S. Virginia Dare Trail. Upon arrival both individuals were unconscious. One individual had two doses of NARCAN administered, one by the Police Department and one by the Fire Department. The other had one dose of NARCAN administered by the Police Department. Both individuals survived.
