Arrests:

Breaking and Entering: On August 22, 2021 officers received a call in reference to vehicles being broken into in the area of 1000 Tenth Ave. After an investigation on scene a suspect was identified and warrants were issued for an arrest. The offender was found and arrested on August 25, 2021.

Intoxicated and Disruptive: On August 24, 2021 in the 1200 block of S. Memorial Blvd., officers responded to a disturbance call. Upon arrival officers learned of a verbal domestic between the two parties. One offender was subsequently arrested for being Intoxicated and Disruptive.

Intoxicated and Disruptive: On August 28, 2021 officers responded the area of E. First St. and Hwy. 158 in reference to a disturbance call. Upon arrival officers learned of a argument between siblings in a vehicle. One offender was arrested for Intoxicated and Disruptive and Resist, Delay and Obstruct a Law Enforcement officer.

Incidents

Breaking and Entering: On August 15, 2021 officers responded to the areas of the 800 and the 1000 blocks of South Croatan Hwy for breaking and entering's. Upon arrival officers found both locations had been forcible entered. Video footage provided photographs and individuals were later identified after a good Samaritan recognized the photos and called law enforcement. Juvenile petitions are being sought against the offenders.

Overdose: On August 6, 2021 officers responded to the 200 block of E. Avalon in reference to an overdose. Law enforcement officers administered Narcan. The individual refused transport to the Outer Banks Hospital. The individual was subsequently arrested on federal warrants.
