**CONTINUANCE OF STATE OF
EMERGENCY
FOR COVID-19 PANDEMIC
Town of Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina
04.05.2022**

WHEREAS, the Governor of North Carolina declared a State of Emergency on March 10, 2020, and has issued multiple statewide Executive Orders to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the State; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Dare County and Kill Devil Hills declared a State of Emergency due to the unprecedented public health threat posed by COVID-19, a life-threatening communicable disease that had been found in North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Kill Devil Hills aligned all local restrictions, prohibitions, and effective dates with those contained in Executive Orders issued by the Governor of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Executive Order No. 256 acknowledge that new SARS-CoV-2 subvariants of COVID-19 are emerging;


NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the Town of Kill Devil Hills by Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes, formerly titled the North Carolina Emergency Management Act, The State of Emergency in the Town of Kill Devil Hills is extended and shall remain in effect until rescinded; all individuals and businesses in Kill Devil Hills shall adhere to the provisions of all state-wide Executive Orders issued by the Governor of North Carolina until modified, extended, or rescinded.

I hereby order this declaration to be: 1) distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; 2) filed with the Town Clerk; 3) posted conspicuously on the Kill Devil Hills website; 4) submitted to the State's webEOC critical incident management system; and 5) distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

This declaration is entered this 5th day of April 2022, and shall remain in effect unless modified or rescinded.
