It is with much gratitude that I submit the attached report on actual services that the Community Care Clinic of Dare (CCCD) provides to your Town's residents.

To address the complete lack of dental access for uninsured, financially challenged, adults, CCCD is planning to integrate a safety net dental clinic, more than doubling our current budget. CCCD receives approximately 25 calls per week for dental needs in addition to requests from almost every active patient.

CCCD, although a charitable clinic, provides high-quality, comprehensive primary care. We are patient-centered and focused on prevention and treatment of both acute and chronic conditions. Through our network of partners, CCCD transitions patients through vulnerable periods in their lives and is able to access any services or medical care needed.

Your investment in our clinic reduces overall costs of health care to the community. Uninsured adults who have access to reliable, quality health care are more productive citizens with more dollars to spend in their local community.

I welcome you to come for a visit and meet our staff and volunteers any time.
