On behalf of Interfaith Community Outreach (ICO) Board of Directors, we extend our heartfelt appreciation for the continued partnership and financial support the Town of Kill Devil Hills has awarded to ICO. The mission of (ICO) is to provide assistance to individuals facing a temporary emergency crisis and our vision is "Bridging the Gap" where no one will face an emergency crisis alone. In 2021 ICO provided \$381,503 in direct services to our community of which \$59,503.91 went to Kill Devil Hills Residents in need. ICO helped 950 families consisting of 1,876 individuals.
