Dear Town of Kill Devil Hills Board of Commissioners,

The Community Care Clinic of Dare (CCCD) has a new logo representing our integration of health care services to care for the whole individual. We are the first integrated medical-dental-pharmacy healthcare facility dedicated to serving adults without affordable health insurance who live/work in Dare County.

CCCD is sustained through individual/business donations, county and local government contributions, State grants, foundations, and fundraising events. We are so grateful for your support as our budget has increased with each new service line.

The contribution that you make to the Community Care Clinic of Dare reduces overall costs of health care to the community. Providing care for acute and chronic conditions alleviates overuse of the Emergency Department and helps prevent poor outcomes. We also offer cancer screenings, lab work, MRI/CT, referrals to specialists, diagnostics, and mental health providers. Patients with diabetes receive diabetic retinal eye screenings with our EYENUK retinal camera, and if necessary, are referred immediately to Wagner Retina and Macula Specialist for treatment to prevent vision loss.

As the only Syringe Services Program in the county, CCCD is contributing to harm reduction of substance use. CCCD now offers Vivitrol, an injectable medication to treat opioid and alcohol use disorder. Vivitrol suppresses the craving for these substances, and paired with counseling, it supports the individual to become completely drug-free.

Our health educators and nurse navigators assess all patients for social determinants of health including food, clothing, shelter, personal safety, transportation, employment, substance use, etc. Closed loop referrals to local resources ensure our patients receive the support they need.

I welcome you to come for a visit, a tour, and meet our staff and volunteers. By the summer, we'll have the dental facility up and running.

CCCD met performance outcome measures for patients diagnosed with diabetes/hypertension

- Only 16.0% of patients diagnosed with diabetes had A1c > 9%
- 67.1% of patients diagnosed with hypertension have BP < 140/90
