Engineering and design plans for the proposed 2024-2025 Street, Drainage, and Right-Of-Way Improvements Projects have been completed and plans are available for review at the Town of Kill Devil Hills Public Services Department. The Town has solicited construction bids for this work and intends to present bid proposals and engineering recommendations to the Board of Commissioners at their May 13, 2024 meeting. At that time, the Board will consider project implementation including drainage improvements and paving as outlined below:

Wrightsville Boulevard Phase 1 (*approximately 0.63 miles*) - Improvements will include paving, drainage, water main, and related work as follows:

- **Goddard Street to Calvin Street:** Work will include water main replacement, asphalt paving, drainage improvements and some driveway work.
- **Calvin Street to Atlantic Street:** Work will include asphalt paving, drainage improvements and some driveway work.

Wrightsville Boulevard Phase 2 (*approximately 0.39 miles*) - Improvements will include paving, drainage, water main, and related work as follows:

- **Atlantic Street to E. Dean Street:** Work will include water main replacement, asphalt paving, drainage improvements and some driveway work.
- **E. Dean Street to Neptune Drive:** Work will include asphalt paving, drainage improvements and some driveway work.
- **Neptune Drive to Carolyn Drive:** Work will include water main replacement, asphalt paving, drainage improvements and some driveway work.

With approval by the Board of Commissioners, we anticipate the start of construction on about September 9, 2024.

According to tax records, your property is adjacent to the proposed project construction area. If the Board of Commissioners approves work within your area, you will need to remove all private property items from the Town's right-of-way area by the start of the construction date listed above. It is possible that privately owned materials that are not removed could be damaged or destroyed by the contractor in the course of his work. This includes the following: fencing, landscaping materials or plantings, irrigation, and gravel or stone parking areas. There are two exceptions to this requirement: (1) your mailbox, which the contractor will be responsible for maintaining and (2) your driveway(s) which may be modified or replaced by the contractor according to the project plans if the original installation was approved by the Town.

Please be aware that this project has been designed to manage stormwater runoff within the Town-owned right-of-way areas. Because of the associated requirements for drainage areas, private property items cannot be placed or replaced in the Town's right-of-way after the project is completed.
