ICO was able to help 370 Kill Devil Hills families last fiscal year from 2022-2023 giving Kill Devil Hills residents \$105,694 in monetary outreach with the following areas: Car Insurance, Car Payments, New Tires, Car Repairs, Donated Car, Budget Counseling, Cell Phone Minutes, Mental Health Counseling, Physician fees, Prescriptions, Dental, Mortgage, Rent, Lot Rent, Security Deposits, Housing Assistance, Gas Vouchers, Veteran Outreach & Cancer Outreach, (including medical transportation and monthly living expenses), Electric and Water Bills, Bus Tickets (to where they have support), Home Rehab, Ramps, Roofing, Water Heaters, Plumbing, Childcare, Cremations, & Referrals to other agencies.

Interfaith Community Outreach “Provides Assistance to Individuals and families facing a Temporary Emergency Crisis in Dare and Currituck Counties”. Our Vision is Bridging the Gap: *Where no one will face an Emergency Crisis Alone.*

Interfaith Community Outreach (ICO), Community is part of our name because it’s at the heart of who we are. Over the past 20 years ICO has provided over 5.4 million dollars of direct support and has been *Bridging the Gap*” in our community serving and helping our neighbors in need, from the single father in cancer treatment at risk of losing his home to the neighbor who can’t afford for an urgently needed prescription. We understand that unexpected crises can happen to anyone, and rapid, compassionate support reflects the values of our community. Outreach is more than helping just one person. It is about being present day after day to help the waitress, store clerk, veteran, firefighter, teacher, grandmother, friend, coworker, neighbor – anyone who urgently needs a helping hand.

PROGRAMS:

- Temporary Emergency Outreach
- Cancer Outreach
- Disaster Outreach
- Veteran Outreach
- Home Rehab Outreach
- Mental Health Outreach

This is how your ICO can help but not limited to: Since 2004 ICO has provided over 4 million dollars of direct support to our neighbors in need.

- Rent, mortgage, transportation: greyhound bus, auto insurance, car payments, transportation supplies, car repairs, donation of cars, gas vouchers, dental, physicians, surgery, prescriptions, mental health, other medical needs, utilities, water, electric, phone minutes if you are looking for a job or need for medical appointment, childcare, disaster relief, referrals to other agencies.
- Cancer Outreach (\$3-5K per resident and medical transportation reimbursement for each cancer medical trip)
- Veteran Outreach (all areas of direct services as well as helping Veterans get services, DD214, outreach)
- Home Rehab Projects (ramps, bathrooms, home repairs)
- Disaster Outreach (Partner with Dare County & Outer Banks Community Foundation ICO will case manage residents in need after a disaster)

How ICO is Making a Difference

- Assisting cancer patients with travel expenses relating to treatment
- Partnering to help those most vulnerable with energy assistance.
- Quickly providing prescription and other emergency needs
- Supporting veterans and those with physical need in accessing their home safely

What You Can Do to Help

- Donate – over 90%* of the donations ICO receives are used for direct community support, not employee salaries or other expenses.
